DAVE McKENNA will be the guest of HJS on Sunday evening, January 10. (Note that date: it's the second, rather than the first Sunday of the month.) The hour: θ o'clock, as usual. The place: Jonathan Temple, 700 Blue Hills Avenue.

One of the best, though least touted, of jazz pianists, Dave McKenna has played with the Herman herd (1950-51), the bands of Charlie Ventura, Bobby Hackett, the Zoot Sims-Al Cohn group and the Gene Krupa Trio. John S. Wilson in his "Collector's Jazz" says of Dave's playing, "edgy, charging...crisp...delightful effervescence...rollicks along (with a mediocre group) like an undaunted horse in blinders." In short, you'll like him. With him will be Ernie Wilson, bass. Joe Porcaro will serve at the drums.

THE AL LEPAK CONCERT JAZZ BAND performed beautifully, as always, at the concert presented at Trinity College November 30th under the sponsorship of HJS (through the public-spirited generosity of Local 400, American Federation of Musicians). Incidentally, this fine band is being heard every other Sunday afternoon at the Hofbrau on Asylum Street. It deserves an audience.
