If you didn't make the meeting Saturday evening, don't feel badly and go out back to eat worms. You'll see much of the show Toshiko and her group put on in a TV presentation taped on the scene by Channel 24. (Dates will be announced before the telecasts.)

HEMMED IN by TV equipment and lacking sufficient time, we had to curtail one of the principal items of business — a discussion of the proposed bus trip to Manhattan to attend a day of the Eastern Conference of Jazz Societies. Twenty-two members and friends signed up that evening for the trip. No doubt others, who were not present, would like to go. Hence this announcement:

THE BUS will leave the Hartford Railway Station at 10:30 Saturday morning, September 30. The capacity is 40 persons, the round-trip fare being \$6 per person. The bus will go directly to the door of St. Peter's Fine Arts Center at 54th and Lexington, arriving in time for the afternoon session. (See enclosed program of events.) The bus will leave New York at approximately 1 AM, after the guided tour of jazz spots, the point of departure to be decided during the trip. You will arrive in Hartford at approximately 3:30 or 4 AM, giving you most of Sunday morning to sleep off your exertions.

PLEASE SIGN the enclosed pre-registration slip, which will admit you to all events for \$2 instead of \$3. Bring the slip with you when you board the bus. Bus fares and re-registration dues will be collected on the bus.
